Senior Phone Patrol

Senior Phone Patrol is a free service offered to residents of Sparks who are senior citizens living alone or disabled persons. The program is simple. A member of the Sparks Police calls each participant daily between 6:00am and 9:00am to check on them. Participants answer the phone and acknowledge they are okay. If no answer is received, an officer is sent to the participant's home to check their welfare.

What if I won't be home when Senior Phone Patrol calls? We have setup an answering service for participants to let us know anytime they will not be answering the call from Senior Phone Patrol.

History of the Program

In 1989, Sparks Police created the Senior Phone Patrol to check on senior citizens living alone in our community. The program has proven valuable to participants who unexpectedly find themselves in need of help. There have been occasions when a participant didn't answer the Phone Patrol call due to illness or injury. An officer responded to the participant's home, checked their welfare and summoned medical aid if needed. This free service offers peace of mind knowing Sparks Police are checking on you or a loved one.



Something More for Participants

During the month of December, we host a holiday party for participants to enjoy a family-style gathering and a holiday meal. Many participants do not have nearby family support, and the holiday party is something participants look forward to.

Requirements

- Must be a resident of the City of Sparks
- Must be a senior citizen or disabled person status
- Must live alone or be the sole caregiver of a disabled person
